Directora Blanco's Message

It is hard to believe that we have been in school for 6 weeks! We are in person this school year, but things are far from a "normal" school year. I recently read that a student who is in 5th grade has not had a normal school year since 2nd grade, this was eye opening for me! Our youngest students in Kinder, 1st and 2nd grade have never had a "normal" school year! What does this mean? This means that team work and collaboration between home and school are even more important! Many students are behind academically and that is to be expected, we look for growth! At Grace Hudson, we are working on accelerating learning through engaging activities at school. Since literacy skills in any language transfer over when learning a new language or solidifying your native language, reading to and with students (TK-5th grade) in the language spoken at home is super vital. This supports learning how to read, write, listen and speak in a dual language immersion program setting. Other activities you can do easily at home to support language and math are cooking, shopping at the store, singing, counting, watching a TV program together and talking about what happened, why it happened and how it relates to the child personally. And of course, playing! Doing all physical activities together improve mind and body, and children love to do things with the people who love and care about them.

Academics are important, but to learn effectively social and emotional health lays the ground work for success in other areas. All of this has suffered due to the pandemic and we are seeing it at school. Students are having some difficulty with structure, schedules and basic social skills such as taking turns, sharing, using your words and keeping hands and feet to yourself. In classrooms, we are teaching expectations in various ways. At home, playing board games, all sports activities whether they are organized or tossing a ball back and forth in the yard assist students in developing these much needed life skills. Lost and Found

If you are going to be gone from school for more than three days due to an emergency, trip and/or illness, Independent Study is available. Please give us 2 weeks lead time, if possible so that your child's teacher can get the work ready. We are only able to give a total of 15 days for the entire school year and anything after that absences will be unexcused. Finally, all work must b completed upon the day of return to school in order for teachers to correct it and give credit. If the work is not complete, unexcused absences will be noted. COVID TESTING

It is vital to the health of our community to maintain high standards when it comes to illness and/or symptoms of COVID-19. Please check in with your children every morning to make sure that they don't have any symptoms of COVID-19. If they do, please call the office and we can schedule a rapid COVID test. It is important to keep kids in school if they are healthy and keep kids home if they are sick! If your family has been exposed to a COVID-19 positive person, please call the office immediately so we can take the proper precautions and give you your options.
