Drop Off/Pick Up

1. Please cross all students in the designated crosswalk. Do not cross in front of the cars in the drop off/pick up zone or in the middle of the street. Cars cannot see small children.

2. When dropping students off or picking them up, please <u>do not exit your cars.</u> It slows the line and causes traffic jams. Please have your children exit on the right side.

Please have students backpacks, jackets and lunches all together in the car for quick and easy exit.

3. Please do not use the empty lot next to the South State Street parking lot to drop off students. Many students who live in the neighborhood use that as a pathway to walk to school. In the past, cars have almost backed into groups of walking students or have sped in and narrowly missed students. Please use the South Dora Street drop off zone.

4. School begins at 8:00am. There is a warning bell at 7:58am and another bell will ring at 8:00am. The gate at the South Dora Street drop off zone will close shortly after school begins at 8:00am. If your child arrives after 8:00am, you will need to use and park in the South State Street parking lot. Attendance is taken at 8:05am and supervision ends at this time as well. If you arrive at 8:05am or after, please walk your young child to the office, please don't allow them to do this on their own
